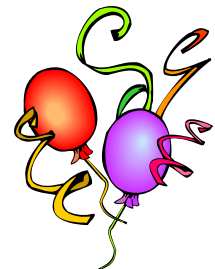

A huge thank you to all who participated in Trick or Eat this year and to everyone who donated food items. It was another successful campaign and we are very grateful for the generosity of this community!

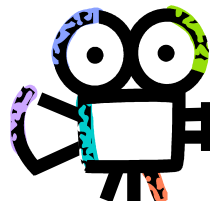


Scotland and Ireland
