

two types: identical and fraternal

Identical





- -develop from ONE egg that splits into two cells that each develop into seperate embryos
- -ALWAYS the same gender
- -if separation is NOT complete--> conjoined twins

Fraternal

- -develop when two separate eggs are fertilized
- -may or may not be the same gender
- -no more alike physically than any normal brother or sister

Cloning

Genetic Engineering



- redesigning genes to do specific things
- species that have had genetics manipulated are called transgenic
- Ex
 - -bacteria used to produce insulin
 - -Round-Up ready corn
 - -stem cell research for organ transplantation, repair
