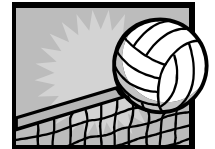

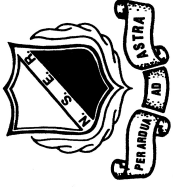
Grad Fees 2010
