Miramichi Emergency Centre for Women



Miramichi Youth House offers temporary housing for both male and female youth ages 16-19 in times of crisis and emergency. No other agency or organization in Northern New Brunswick serves the 16 to 19 age group. The Youth House operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. **There is currently 1 person living at the Youth House and another 13 receiving services.**
