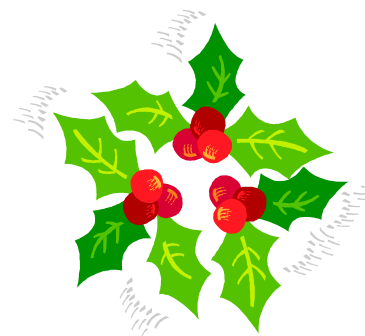
In the Spirit of Christmas

The NSER Yearbook Committee invites you to place a congratulatory message for the special grad in your life. Messages should not exceed 15 words.

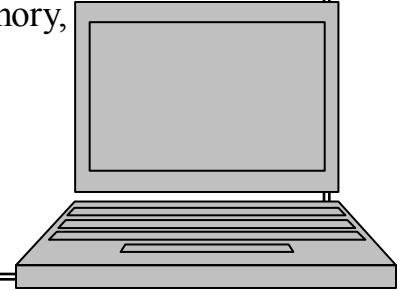
