Parent/Public Bullying Presentation - May 9

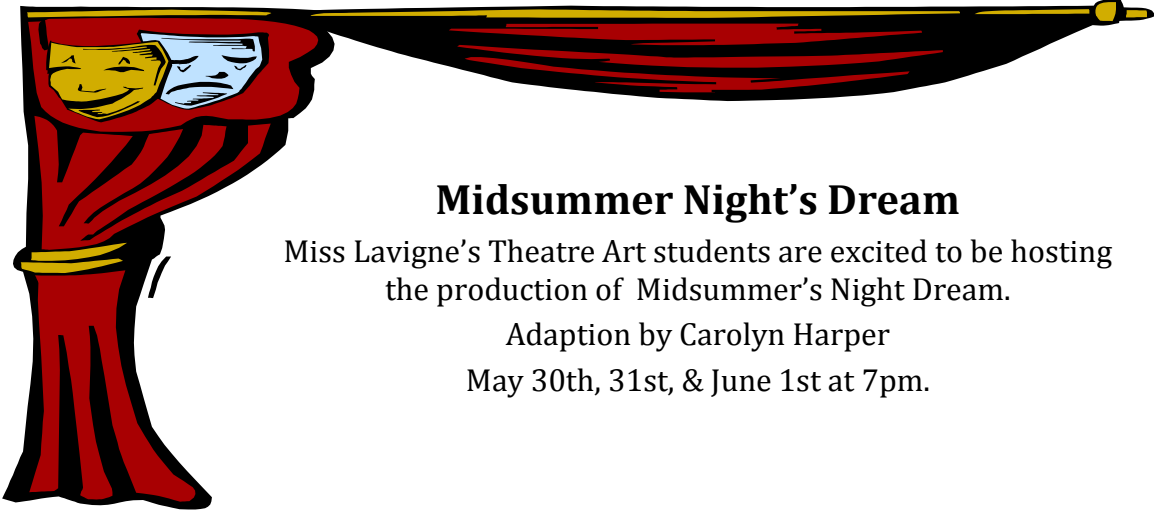
Our district is partnering with the City of Miramichi to bring the Rev. Dale Lang to the Miramichi to do presentations on the topic of bullying. Rev. Lang is the Anglican Priest whose 17-year old son Jason was shot to death on April 28, 1999, by a 14-year old boy at W.R. Myers High School in Taber, Alberta.

Because his son was an innocent victim of an angry bullied boy, Rev. Lang has a deep personal interest in minimizing bullying everywhere. "Since Jason's death, I've had people come to me -- some of them senior citizens -- and tell me about being bullied in grade school. They tell me they can still see the faces of the bullies," he said. "It made me realize how profoundly bullying can affect people."

Dale has spoken in over 350 high schools, numerous conferences teachers' conventions churches and numerous other functions. His message will be about empathy and the profound effects of bullying, and that at the end of the day the whole point he wants to make is that we have to be compassionate people who actually care about others, even the people what are tough for us to like.

Parent/Public presentation will occur at the JMH Theatre on Monday evening, May 9th, 2011, from 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm.
