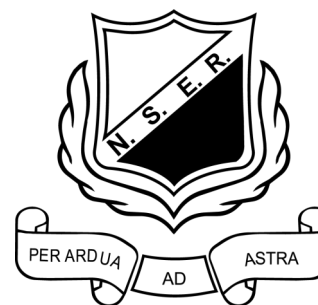

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to another great school year. I am looking forward to all the great things we have at NSER: our sports, clubs, drama and much much more. Last year we introduced the Academic Incentive as part of our school improvement plan. We saw our absenteeism drop from 36% to 18%! This year we are focusing in on homework. The surveys from last year showed that many of our students don't do homework. Parents also felt they were unaware of homework. So this year we will be using the student agendas on a daily basis. All teachers' grades 7-12 will be putting homework on the board every day. Students will copy the homework in the agendas. They will have time to work on their homework during our ½ hour study block. Teachers will be monitoring the agendas and I would ask that parents do the same. This initiative not only helps students get their work done, but prepares them in organizing, scheduling and maintaining daily routines.

The other area that needs improvement is tardiness. Many students are coming to school late which causes them to miss valuable instruction time and disrupts class. This year we will be requesting late slips and should this behavior become repetitive students will be given 1 detention for every 3 lates.
