Middle School "**We School**" is hosting their first fundraiser. On the week of Oct. 3 to 7th the group will be having a bake sale during lunch and break.

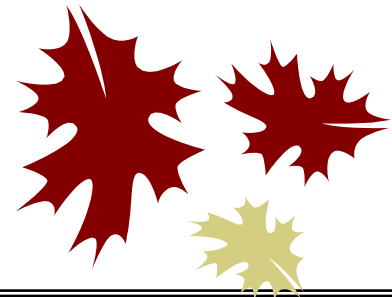
