
Over 40 Universities, Colleges, and private schools from the Atlantic Provinces will be there with information. They will be able to answer any of your questions or concerns.




Middle School **"We School"** is hosting their first fundraiser. On the week of Oct. 3 to 7th the group will be having a bake sale during lunch and break.


