Re: Bus Route changes as a result of the planned closure of Sutherland Brooke Bridge Red Bank.

The Sutherland Brook Bridge will be closed on Monday, January 30 until February 11th.

Following are the Bus Route changes required to accommodate the transportation of students during the Sutherland Brook Bridge closure on Route 420 in Red Bank. It is anticipated the closure will be for 2 weeks.

MORNING RUN

Bliss McAllister Bus 2 will transport the students from the Red Bank Post Office and the Indian Gardens Road Area after he has completed his first route.

Suzie Silliker Bus 14 will do her normal route but in reverse order, starting in the Cassilis area at approx. 7:10 am, heading East on Route 420 to South Esk, then West on Route 425 to Sunny Corner.

Jeanette Curtis Bus 29 will do her route in reverse order starting at the Red Bank end of Route 415 at 7:15 am to Warwick Settlement to Route 8 and then East on Route 8 to Miramichi and west on Route 425 to Sunny Corner.

EARLY AFTERNOON RUN - 1:45 Dismissal NSEE

Bus 63 Linda Stewart will do The Indian Garden Road Area.

Bus 29 Jeanette Curtis will leave NSEE with students from her route as well as those of Bus 63 Linda Stewart to South Esk and Warwick Sett.

LATE AFTERNOON RUN - 2:45 Dismissal NSEE & NSER

Bus 63 Linda Stewart will do the Indian Garden Rd. area as well as her own bus route.

Bus 14 Suzie Silliker will Leave NSEE and NSER with her students and those of Bus 29 Jeanette Curtis for South Esk, Cassilis, and Warwick and meet Bus 29 In South Esk. Bus 29 will continue on route to Warwick and Bus 14 will deliver the South Esk and Cassilis Students.
